ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

- Students are expected to arrive in Rome on **Sunday 3 September 2017**. Departure is on **Saturday 16 September 2017**. Students will not be accepted who can only attend part of the course.
- Applicants must obtain and provide proof of adequate **health, travel and civil liability insurance** for the duration of the Summer Course.

COSTS & EXPENSES

- Student applicants who are students at the time of applying and are studying in one of the Member States of the European Space Agency (ESA) are not required to pay any course fees and receive accommodation free of charge. This is arranged in advance by the ECSL.
- Young Professional applicants and applicants from non-ESA member states must be able to pay the course fee of **€1,200**. Accommodation is included in this fee (arranged in advance by the ECSL).
- All applicants are expected to pay for their own transportation to and from the Summer Course as well as their food and other cost of living Warsaw. Some pre-organised excursions will be covered by the ECSL; other excursions may be recommended to students at their own expense.
